- ★ New electric service and panel have been installed
- ★ Gym and Boutique Room furnace has been replaced
- ★ Work is completed on our Ladies' and Men's restroom adjacent (south) of Fellowship Hall
- ★ Work on handicap accessible ramp will be finished by the end of October
- ★ Renovations to the North Parlor, its entryway and stairs is mostly completed and the room is usable
- ★ Renovation of Fellowship Hall has started

While work in Fellowship Hall makes the hall mostly unusable, there are “passageways” to access the kitchen, restrooms, exits, offices, second floor and gymnasium.
